If a violation of any of the Covenants occurs, the HOA may pursue all remedies available under Indiana law. Remedies include, but not limited to, the right to secure injunctive relief. The HOA shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees, costs and expenses incurred as a result thereof. 	<u>Pool Fences</u> : Where required, shall be decorative type with some screen landscaping on the sides exposed to the streets. All pool fences must meet requirements of the City Engineer, City of Lafayette, codes and regulations, including, but not limited to, the requirement that all fences must be six (6) feet in height.
